

## Draft Ardaun LAP Progress Update



Following the consideration of the Draft Ardaun Local Area Plan (LAP) 2018-2024, the Chief Executive's Report and the associated environmental assessments, Galway City Council Members by resolution decided that the draft LAP should be amended. A total of 19 material alterations of the LAP are proposed.

The proposed material alterations went on public display from **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2018 to Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2018**, and were also referred to prescribed authorities.

The proposed material alterations are accompanied by SEA Screening of Material Alterations prepared in accordance with the Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) Regulations 2004 (as amended) and Screening for AA prepared in accordance with Article 6 of the Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC).

The Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) stipulates that following this public consultation period the Chief Executive (CE) will prepare a report on any submissions or observations received with respect to the proposed material alterations and present this report to the Council for consideration.

Following the issuing of the CE's report, the Council Members have a period of six weeks to consider the material alterations and the CE's Report.

The Members of the Council shall, by resolution, having considered the proposed material alterations and the CE's report adopt the LAP with or without the proposed alteration.

The Ardaun LAP 2018-2024 comes into effect four weeks from the day it is adopted.
