- 1. Housing & Social Inclusion
- 2. Planning

- 4. Transportation
- 5. Climate Action, Environment, Recreation and Amenity

Following the adoption of the SPC Scheme by Galway City Council, nomination of Sectoral representatives to the Strategic Policy Committees will be undertaken.
