



Healthy Galway City LCDC Update – July 2022 – 20/07/2022

Healthy Galway City:

- County and City Management Association (CCMA) approved a new Healthy City/County Coordinator role at a Local Authority level to form part of HIF Round 4
- Recruitment for Healthy Galway City Coordinator began April 2022.
- Aisling Colreavy employed as HGC Coordinator role responsible for delivery of Healthy Ireland Round 4 (1st June 2022 – 31st December 2025)

Healthy Ireland Round 3:

- Final Financial and Progress Reports are currently at “Submitted” stage and awaiting final approval from Pobal

Healthy Ireland Round 4:

- Pobal have confirmed an allocation of €40,000 for the period 1st June to 31st December 2022 to allow delivery of priority health and wellbeing initiatives and to support the planning process relating to HIF 2023 – 2025
- The €40,000 being allocated to Local Authorities for the period 1st June 2022 to 31st December 2022 is to allow for:
 - Capacity building and planning for the application process for 2023 – 2025
 - The delivery of any activities in the health and wellbeing space that have been identified as a priority in 2022
 - A contribution to community health and wellbeing initiatives in response to the arrival of Ukrainian refugees in the city / county
- Proposed activities in 2022 do not require pre-approval from Pobal but contribute to the goals set out in Healthy Ireland: A Framework for Improved Health and Wellbeing 2013 – 2025 and Healthy Ireland Strategic Action Plan 2021 – 2025 and be approved by LCDC
- Indicative allocations of €40,000 per annum for the 2023 – 2025 period
- Healthy Galway City Steering Committee met to review progress and propose activities and budget for 2022
- Healthy Ireland Round 4 2022 Template for Actions and Budget Breakdown July 2022 circulated for review and final approval by LCDC



Additional Funds:

- safefood Community Food Initiatives 2022 – 2024: €9100 per annum for the delivery of two Community Events and two – three small projects to promote awareness of and increase understanding of healthy eating in the community
 - CFI Steering Committee met twice in May and agreed on proposals for Community Events and smaller projects
- Galway City Council Creative Ireland Funding 2022: €10,000 for the delivery of “Reconnecting Communities”; A creativity and wellbeing programme for older people in Galway City
