FM) on the morning of the 26th of September 2022, GCCN wishes to express our condemnation to such racist and discriminatory comments. GCCN also wishes to offer our complete and unequivocal support to the Galway Traveller Movement (GTM) and the wider Traveller Community, including full support for the statement made by GTM (please see below) that includes calls for the suspension of CIIr Crowe pending We find it extremely frustrating and disappointing that, during the same week of the launch of Misleór, a festival celebrating nomadic cultures, including Traveller culture, the focus is once again on a public representative promoting anti-Traveller rhetoric in the local media.




