Key issues dealt with since last Plenary	The Minister's Draft Direction on the Galway City Development Plan 2023-2029. The Ardaun Local Area Plan 2018-2024, which is due to be reviewed will be a priority in 2023. Preparation of Local Area Plans for the Headford Road and Murroogh will commence after the Ardaun LAP review is completed. The Castlegar Area Plan is paused pending a decision on the N6 GCRR. Cllr Frank Fahy declared the Ring Road is a dead duck and cannot happen. A multidisciplinary team, led by Reddy Architecture, is preparing a Spatial Framework for 21 acres at Sandy Road. It is envisaged that 700-850 homes, including mixed tenure and intergenerational homes, can be provided as well as some commercial space. It is expected to go to public consultation by the end of March. Heads of agreement are being finalised with the LDA on the Dyke Road site. It is anticipated that 175 residential units and some commercial space will be provided. The Black Box will remain is use until an alternative is available. A planning application will be made in 2024. Briefing on Residential Zoned Land Tax. Briefing on the ePlanning Project which will enable online planning applications. SPC Work Programme presented. Schedule of meetings agreed.
