Summary

Work has commenced on multiple actions, motivated by availability of specific funding opportunities that tied in closely with the strategic objectives and individual actions. Main objective of these early interventions was to create financial and other resource to underpin the implementation of actions.

26 projects and initiatives were underway in June 2022, now growing to 57 in June 2023. Galway City is a direct partner or stakeholder in roughly 50% of those.
