

Aims & Objective

To stimulate NTE activity through the development of enhanced collaborative structures supported by the Night-Time Economy Advisor.

The anticipated outcomes are:

- The development of a sustainable structure within the local authority for longer-term/ongoing work in the area of the NTE to include a new Committee/Working Group and consultation process.
- A cohesive action plan including a range of proven interventions to include activities for different agegroups and different time spans.
- A plan for the future sustainability of the structure.



Key Deliverables

- Establish a <u>Night-Time Economy</u>
 <u>Committee/Working Group</u> made up of key stakeholders and represent the different aspects of the NTE.
- <u>Conduct a consultation process</u> to engage the local community in the process of developing ideas for the NTE.
- <u>Highlight challenges and opportunities and</u> potential solutions.
- <u>Review existing funding structures</u> at local and national level to highlight potential funding streams for the Action Plan.
- <u>Develop a cohesive action plan</u> including a range of proven intervention activities for different age groups and different periods that are diverse, inclusive, and accessible.

Late-Night Events Pilot Scheme


