It is proposed that the Case Study focuses on the English Language Supports provided by Galway City Partnership. The case study will seek to outline the context and demand for the support, explain and illustrate the methodology and practice, and collect feedback from beneficiaries describing the impact of the support.

The support is targeted at International Protection Applicants and takes a holistic approach to developing English language competencies as well as developing self-confidence and active, conscious and purposeful engagement with the wider community.

A key feature of the Case Study will highlight the breadth and depth of delivery. We deploy a variety of instructional methodologies and engagement paradigms seeking to support individuals from many countries with a variety of learning styles. This approach is very successful in reducing drop-out rates and assists greatly in the co-design of curricula.

The Case Study will include testimonials from a very small sample of the 150 plus beneficiaries and will be accompanied by a supporting narrative giving more detail on the practice and approaches as well as the challenges faced in delivering the support.
